



## Sydenham

### Map #33, Lindenwood

At km 125.6 (25th Edition) the Trail crosses a small stream, then heads uphill and after turning left briefly enters into a meadow. Continuing west onto a new BTC property purchase named Lindenwood, the Trail wanders through a small wetland section eventually reaching a large series of meadows. The Trail follows the south fence-line of the property eventually turning right (north) at the west end of the BTC property. The Trail then follows another fence-line into a hardwood forest. Slowly the hiker will see the escarpment emerging from the meadow. The Trail then meets the Lindenwood Side Trail and Loop as well as the Lindenwood Road.

### Lindenwood Side Trail and Loop

The Lindenwood Side Trail makes a 2.8 km loop through a mostly hardwood forest. Interesting sites to keep watch for are the huge erratic of limestone at the far south end of the loop and the fossils along with the alvar at the west end of the loop. The loop re-emerges where it started at the main Trail.

Main Trail Deleted = 1.4 km

New Main Trail = 2.2 km

New Side Trail = 2.8 km
