



**Beaver Valley
Map #25 (and #27)**

This reroute immediately north of the popular Old Baldy lookout moves the Trail to the west off the 3rd Line and Sideroad 7B and returns it to the original optimum route. From the north it arcs off the unopened 3rd Line road allowance to descend the escarpment across a scree slope. It follows the base of the escarpment for a distance before ascending to the top through a spectacular natural pass. It then follows the top of the escarpment, skirts McCluskey's Rock and descends a wide east/west valley before turning south to join the existing Ken Young Side Trail, the west arm of which now becomes main trail. The reroute was made possible by new handshake agreements with three generous landowners and the acquisition in partnership with the Ontario Heritage Trust of one property (the Hughes property).

- New Main Trail Route = 2.7 km
- Deleted Main Trail = 3.2 km
- Deleted Trail From Road = 2.8 km
- Ken Young Side Trail = 800 metres
