

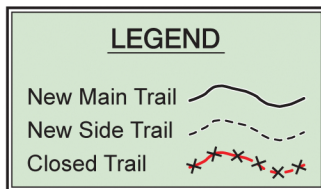
## Sydenham Map #31, Clearview

As you are heading south on 8th Concession North and approach a bend in the road, keep a close watch for the right turn blaze. The main Trail now heads off to the west, down an embankment into a hardwood forest. The Trail climbs along a low escarpment ridge and then once more descends this to cross a bridge over a small stream. On your right the Clearview Side Trail exits while the main Trail continues along the talus base of the escarpment. As the Trail bends away from the escarpment it follows a fence line crossing numerous bridges. The Clearview Side Trail rejoins the Trail on the right. Just ahead the "Polish Tree" is an interesting feature to keep your eye open for. It is a large Beech tree on your left that has carvings written on it in Polish. As the Trail approaches Highway 26 it makes a sharp left turn to cross the highway. Be aware, this is a busy 4 lane road and hikers should use caution in crossing.
