Map #20 – Pine River Reroute

From km 34.2 (25th Edition), the Trail climbs along a narrow ridge, and then turns left to follow the ridge through dense cedar to the Pine River fishing pond. The Trail turns right along the edge of the pond and then swings right up a steep ravine. Here the *Bell Lookout Side Trail* exits right, 90 m up to the viewpoint over the Pine River Provincial Fishing Area. At the height of land there is a plaque in honour of Grant and Grace Bell, Dufferin Trail pioneers, and a bench in memory of volunteer Hilda Wilson.

This reroute was the result of intensive trail work in the summer of 2009 by Earl Cowan as Dufferin Trail Director and his hearty band of volunteers. It was necessitated by extensive erosion along the former route.

New Route = 420 m

New Side Trail = 90 m
