



Bruce Trail Club Volunteer Position Description

Land Steward

Land Stewards are the long-term caretakers of BTC lands. It is their responsibility to keep an eye on their designated property on behalf of the BTC and the local clubs

Essential Elements:

- Read the Volunteer Orientation Manual.
- Visit property at least 2 times per year, in the spring and fall. Though you are encouraged to visit your property at other times throughout the year.
- Complete the Land Steward Annual Monitoring report in a timely manner and submit it to the Club Land Steward Director.
- Additional site visits may be required if issues arise that need to be addressed, for example, garbage cleanup, leading a tour, consulting on a planned reforestation program, a quick inspection after a serious storm.
- Follow the procedures in the Land Stewardship Training Manual.

It is helpful to have:

- Good observation skills
- Some ability to read and understand a land survey
- Knowledge of local flora and fauna
- Good public relations skills
