# “Taste of Cuba” Contest 2011-12 Rules and Regulations

The **Taste of Cuba Contest** (the "Contest") runs from 12.00 noon (EST) November 15, 2011 to 11:59 a.m. (EST) October 31, 2012 (inclusively, the "Contest Period").

## How to Enter

- a) Any purchaser of a Bruce Trail Conservancy **gift membership** (one or three year), during the Contest period, will automatically be credited with one (1) entry in the Contest.
- b) Any recipient of a Bruce Trail Conservancy **gift membership** (one or three year), during the Contest period, will automatically be credited with one (1) entry in the Contest. If the recipient's membership is a family membership, the first name on the membership card will be the name entered into the contest.
- c) **NO PURCHASE REQUIRED TO ENTER.** You may also enter the Contest simply by submitting a hand-print card with your name, address, city, province, postal code, day and evening telephone numbers, and a 500-word or more handwritten essay on the "My Best Bruce Trail Moment", mail in a postage stamped envelope to: The Bruce Trail Conservancy P.O. Box 857, Hamilton, ON, L8N 3N9. Entries must be post marked during the Contest period.

**Regardless of the method of entry, there is a limit of one (1) Contest entry per person and per address.**

- d) Contest is not open to residents of Quebec.

## Prize

The **Grand Prize** consists of a trip for one (1) to Cuba with Adventure Center. The Grand Prize includes return economy air transportation for one (1) between Toronto and Havana (should the winner be from another city, he/she will be responsible for the difference in cost if any), 7 nights hotels, including 2 nights in central Havana. All other expenses not expressly specified as being included in the Grand Prize (including, but not limited to, transfers, pre/post accommodation, visas, air taxes and travel insurance, transportation between the winner's home and the departure airport, meals, airport taxes, hotel charges other than accommodation (e.g. telephone, fax or cable charges, mini-bar or other hotel services and all other ancillary costs) or expenses or any other costs not specifically listed above as being included in the prize package) are the responsibility of the winner. The winner must be of the age of majority in their respective province of residence, is responsible for obtaining all required travel necessary documentation, if any. The winner must produce proof of adequate travel insurance as defined by the tour operator. All travel completed within 1 year from the draw date (November 15, 2013) - **NO EXTENSIONS APPLY.** All travel arrangements must be made through Adventure Center. Due to the nature of the prize, no alternative travel or accommodation dates are available.

The Bruce Trail Conservancy and Adventure Center make no express or implied warranties of any kind with respect to safety, or performance of the prize. Approximate retail value of the Grand Prize package is approximately \$2,500 (Canadian dollars).

The prize must be accepted as awarded. It may not be transferred or substituted for another prize. No refund or credit to be given for any unused portion of this package. Package is valid for prize winner only, not valid to be transferred to another person, sold or redeemed for cash.

## The Draw

On November 15, 2012 at 1:00 pm at the Bruce Trail Conservancy head office, one (1) selected entrant for the Grand Prize will be randomly selected from among all eligible entries received during the Contest Period.

The Bruce Trail Conservancy will attempt to contact the selected entrant by telephone or e-mail, within twenty-four (24) hours of the draw date. If the selected entrant cannot be contacted by telephone or email (or fails to respond to any telephone or e-mail messages) within forty-eight (48) hours following the draw date, he or she will be disqualified from the Contest and the Bruce Trail Conservancy may, at its sole discretion, select another eligible entrant whom the Bruce Trail Conservancy shall attempt to contact, and who shall in turn be subject to disqualification, in the same manner set out above.

## General Rules

The odds of being the selected entrant are dependent on the total number of entries received during the Contest Period.

To be declared a winner, the entrant whose name is randomly selected must first correctly answer, unaided, a mathematical skill-testing question and otherwise comply with all provisions of these Contest rules.

Entries are subject to verification by the Bruce Trail Conservancy. All entries that are fraudulent, incomplete or that are not received in accordance with these Contest rules will be automatically rejected and will not entitle the entrant to win a prize. Decisions taken by the Bruce Trail Conservancy with respect to all aspects of this Contest, including without limitation eligibility and/or disqualification of entries, are final and binding, without right of appeal.

All entries become the property of the Bruce Trail Conservancy.

By entering this Contest, each entrant absolves the Bruce Trail Conservancy and Adventure Center and their respective officers, The Bruce Trail Conservancy Board of Directors, employees and their respective advertising and promotional agencies, agents, representatives, and contractors from any and all liability for any harm he/she may suffer as a result of participation in the Contest, compliance or noncompliance with these Contest rules and acceptance and use of the prize, and each selected entrant agrees to sign the Bruce Trail Conservancy's form of Declaration of Compliance with the Contest Rules and Release of Liability in this regard before receiving the prize. Declaration and Release documents will be faxed (if selected entrant has a fax number) or delivered to the selected entrant, and must be returned by fax (to the number indicated on the Declaration and Release form) within the time required by the Bruce Trail Conservancy. Once the Declaration and Release documents are completed, signed and received by the Bruce Trail Conservancy, the winner will be contacted by Adventure Center regarding arrangements for the prize.

By entering this Contest, the winner authorizes the Bruce Trail Conservancy, and their respective advertising and/or promotional agencies and their respective representatives to use his/her name, picture, image, voice, and/or statements about the Contest and/or the prize for advertising purposes, and to do so without remuneration of any kind.
