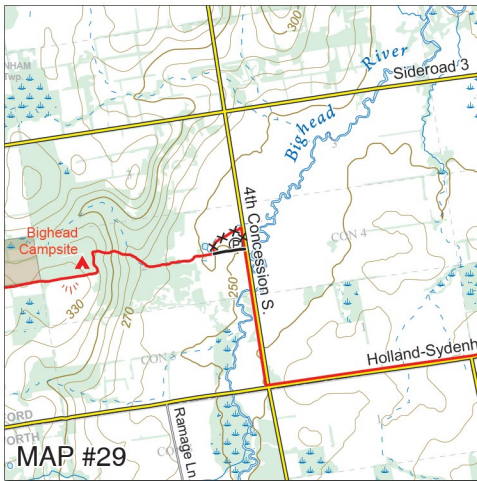

The abandoned trail route went through a patch of wild chervil. As it turned out, hikers were causing the spread of this invasive weed. Accordingly, the Trail has been moved to a drier location while avoiding the spread of wild chervil seeds found on the abandoned route.

Abandoned Route = 425 metres
New Route = 205 metres
