Trail Captain

The Sydenham Club is looking for volunteers to help maintain designated sections of the Bruce Trail. As a Trail Captain, you'll enjoy the pride of taking custody over a section of trail and keeping it in top condition. This is a perfect opportunity for anyone who is looking to increase their connection to the Bruce Trail and natural environment.

Roles and Duties:

- As a Trail Captain you will be responsible for maintaining trail quality in a designated section of Bruce Trail. This may include pruning, vegetation control, re-painting blazes, removing garbage and maintenance of structures.
 - Regularly visit your designated section of Bruce Trail to monitor trail conditions. Trail Captains are vital to managing risk along the Bruce Trail.
 - Produce two Trail Status Reports (TSR) per year. These reports are used to ensure Bruce Trail maintenance and inspection has occurred to fulfill insurance requirements.
 - Participate in work parties with other Trail Maintenance volunteers to complete larger projects.
 - Maintain a log of completed duties and trail maintenance issues.
